### 241204:10 2025-2026 Budget

Clerk presented revised Budget. Amendments as follows;

- Projects set at £1000 thus allowing possible 10% match funding allowing grant funding of £10,000
- Plants £0. All must be either grant funded and/or donated
- Village Hall £165 meeting rent increased from £10 -> £15.00. Council voted unanimously to drop August meeting and accept rent increase
- Cemetery maintenance £215 Cemetery hedge cut
- Training £60 ERNLLCA courses often £20 3 training opportunities
- Repairs £2000. General repairs not wall maintenance. Any wall repairs must be grant funded
- Projected VAT reclaim not as high due to several suppliers not being VAT registered

Council agreed to set precept at £6800 **Resolution passed** Proposed Cllr Dent seconded Cllr Clough. Clerk to submit precept request to NLC. **AP241204:04** 

#### 241204:11 Projects

Decision usually takes 12 weeks. Depending on when/if funding announced Clerk requested assistance with moving project forward
