Total January hours paid 7. Anglian Water (AW) – <u>increased price of installation</u>. Anglian Water have offered a one-off compensation payment of £200 and have offered to pay for the meter installation as this was not carried out correctly at initial installation. Council refuse to accept this offer; take claim to stage 2. Clerk to write to AW to request and to advise AW to contact Chair for all future E mails Wave – Account has been opened; Charges to be as follows £0.23p per m³. Annual Standing charge £77.10. Once water switched on council to monitor monthly Current account as of 31st January 2026 £2410.85 Reserve account £2556.75 National Lottery grant remaining funds - £404.68 (included in £2410.85) <u>Budget 2026/2027.</u> NLC have offered a 3.8% increase on devolved grass cutting to include weed clearance within 30mph areas in the parishes. 3.8% will not cover inflation and the extra work involved. Meeting at NLC 8th January 2025 to discuss. All councillors to attend. Cllr Dent has calculated some of the m² through CAD – to be completed ready for Thursday meeting. 26/27 Budget is extremely tight – Payment of AW invoice has been included in accepted budget. Funds may need to be transferred from reserve account. If AW complaint is successfully upheld, no fund transfer will be required allowing finances to become more stable and healthy. Grove do not currently hold spraying licence however they have been approached by other PC’s with regards to spraying. Precept request 2026/27.
